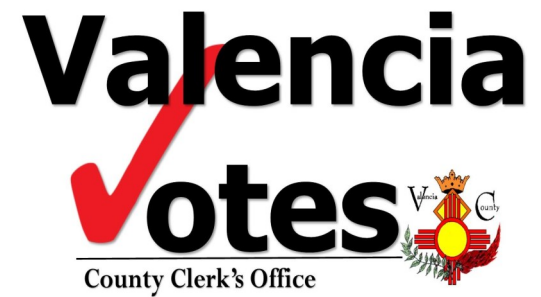

2020 VOTING CONVENIENCE CENTERS & ELECTION INFORMATION



WHAT IS A VOTING CONVENIENCE CENTER?

A Voting Convenience Center (VCC) is a location serving as a polling place at which any registered voter in Valencia County may vote regardless of the precinct in which the voter is assigned.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Voter registration closes 28 days before any election. However, you will have the option to update or register at the County Clerk's Office starting 28 days before the election or at any Early Voting site. This allows you to register and vote on the same day. Any registrations received electronically or in paper form will be held until 35 days after the election. Party affiliation cannot be changed before a Primary Election.



FAQ's

Q. WHAT IS "CONVENIENT" ABOUT VCC'S?

VCC's are about voter choice. Traditional precinct-specific voting required voters to vote only at their assigned voting sites. VCC's provide voters the option of selection among 15 sites and choosing one that is most convenient to their needs and schedule on Election Day.

Q. WILL VOTING STILL BE DONE ON PAPER BALLOTS?

Yes, however instead of pre-printing thousands of ballots, as has been the current practice, your ballot will be printed "on demand" at the VCC of your choosing.

Q. HOW WILL I KNOW WHICH BALLOT I WILL NEED TO VOTE ON?

All 16 VCC locations will be securely connected to the state wide voter registration data base maintained at the county clerk's office. When a voter arrives to vote at a VCC, her/his identity will be verified and the correct precinct will be provided. This information is then used to print the appropriate ballot for the voter. Precincts are assigned based on physical address. It is important to update your voter registration whenever you move.

Q. DO I NEED TO SHOW IDENTIFICATION WHEN I VOTE?

You do not have to present a photo ID. Only if you are registering in NM for the first time and mailed-in your voter registration form without including a copy of your ID or proof of residence, then you must provide identification at the VCC site in order to vote.

Q. WILL SITES BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE AMERICAN DISABILITY ACT (ADA) OF 1990?

Yes, the majority of the VCC sites are the same as those used in previous elections. Room locations may change, but all will meet or exceed ADA accessibility requirements.

FAQ's

Q. WILL I STILL HAVE THE OPTION TO VOTE ABSENTEE OR EARLY?

Yes, absentee and early voting will be carried out in the same fashion as in a standard election setting. To request an absentee ballot you can call the office and request the application, print an application off of our website or you can apply for an absentee ballot online by going to NMVote.org. In order to receive an absentee ballot, you must request one for each election.
