A Resolution Participating in the Local Government Road Fund Program Administered by New Mexico Department of Transportation

WHEREAS, the **Valencia County** and the New Mexico Department of Transportation have entered into a cooperative grant agreement under the Local Government Road Fund Program for a local road project.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be **\$287,333** to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:

WHEREAS, the **Valencia County** shall pay all costs, which exceed the total project cost of **\$287,333**.


NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved in official session that **Valencia County** determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

- The project for this Cooperative Agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.
- The Cooperative Agreement terminates on **12/31/2026** and the **Valencia County** incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.
- The **Valencia County**, Board of County Commissioners, shall have signature authority to bind the **Valencia County** to the terms and conditions of this Cooperative Agreement, and shall have authority to request in writing and secure extensions to the Cooperative Agreement on behalf of the **Valencia County** in the manner set forth by the Cooperative Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the governing body of **Valencia County** to enter into Cooperative Agreement for Project Control Number **L300384** with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for the LGRF Program for fiscal year **2026** for **Jose I. Garcia Rd., & West Aragon Road** as defined under the attached **Exhibit 1 - Pavement Rehabilitation/Improvements, Reconstruction, Full Construction, Drainage Improvements, Blading & Shaping, Traffic Signal Improvements, Parking Lot Improvements, Miscellaneous, Bridge Replacement, Design, Right of Way Acquisition, Roadway Lighting** within the control of **Valencia County** in the State of New Mexico.







EXHIBIT 1

- Pulverize Existing Asphalt
- Subgrade Prep
- Prime Coat
- 3" Asphalt Paving
- Grading of Shoulders
- 4" Double Yellow Centerline & White Shoulder Striping

- **Placement of Speed Humps**
