**APPOINTING & ACKNOWLEDGING MEMBERS  
OF THE  
COUNTY VALUATION PROTEST BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, the Valencia County Commission met upon notice of a Regularly Scheduled Business Meeting duly published on August 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 5:00 P.M. in the Valencia County Administration Building, 444 Luna Avenue, Los Lunas, New Mexico 87031; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 7-38-21 (2001) property owners have the right to protest the value or classification determined for their property for property taxation purposes; and,

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 7-38-25 (1997) provides in pertinent part that there shall be a county valuation protest board in each county, to hear and decide protests of determinations made by county assessors & protested under Section 7-37-24 NMSA 1978, consisting of three voting members & three alternates who shall not hold any elective public office during the term of their appointment nor shall any such member or alternate be employed by the state, a political subdivision or a school district during the term of his appointment, and;

**WHEREAS**, NMSA 1978, Section 7-38-25 (1997) further provides that “one member and one alternate shall be a qualified elector of the county and shall be appointed by the board of county commissioners for a term of two years; one member and one alternate shall be a qualified elector of the county, shall have demonstrated experience in the field of valuation of property and shall be appointed by the board of county commissioners for a term of two years; and one member and one alternate shall be a property appraisal officer employed by the department, assigned by the director and shall be the chairman of the board.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of County Commissioners appoints the following members and their alternates pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 7-38-25 (1997).




