Wood for public pick up

Wood piles of Salt Cedar, Russian Olive, and Siberian Elm trees will be available for public pick up at the NM State Forestry Bosque Thinning Project site in Tome. All piled logs are available to be picked up. Wood chips that are in piles are also available for pick up. **Additionally, all dead and down wood in the designated areas of the project will be available to be picked up.**

Permits are required. Permits can be picked up at no cost on Wednesday, October 18:
Valencia County Fire Administration Office - 444 Luna Ave. Los Lunas 8:00am to 4:30pm

Middle Rio Grande Conservancy Patrol Officers will be in the area. You will need your permit to enter. Each permit is good for one truck to enter. **No trailers are allowed.**

WHEN: Friday, October 20 - 10:00 AM – 2:00 PM (weather permitting)

WHERE: Enter by going West on Calle Del Rio off of 2600 block of Hwy 47. Turn left after crossing over ditch on West end of Calle Del Rio. Project site is 2 miles from this point. Stay on road, go through gate, turn right on levee road.
